

COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN KEY POINTS: FEBRUARY 2021

- On consideration of the most recent NSW Health advice, the Diocese of Parramatta advises that all worshippers in the Diocese need not wear a mask, however it is still recommended especially indoors.
- With the regulations in place of 1 person per 2 square metres, St Matthew's Catholic Church can accommodate 140 parishioners per Mass or service in the Church. You are welcome to make a booking for a weekend Mass by contacting the Parish Office during office hours. Or alternatively you can register your attendance when you get there. No bookings are required for weekday Masses.
- On arrival at the Church, please sanitize your hands using the sanitizer supplied.
- You are required to confirm your name on the attendance sheet. If you haven't made a booking, you will need to provide your name and a contact number for trace purposes. If you wish to attend the same Mass next week, please note next to your name "next week or NW".
- Please sit in the pews in a staggered formation so that social distancing is maintained. If you are from the same family group, you are able to sit together in a pew.
- During communion, please maintain social distancing at all times.
- At the conclusion of Mass, you are requested to please wipe down your seat with the sanitizer wipes supplied in the pews.
- You are requested not to socialize inside or outside the Church but leave as soon as possible after Mass.
- Please do not enter the Church if you are experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms, have a temperature, been in contact with anyone that is either a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 even if you have made a Mass booking.
- We understand the inconvenience the above may cause, but the health of our parishioners and the wider community is our highest concern. We sincerely thank you for understanding, and for playing your part in keeping our community safe.
